



Adobe FAQs: Education Enterprise Agreement (EEA) for primary and secondary schools

Not sure which Adobe licensing option is for you? Our experts are here to demystify the various schemes, plans and agreements available, starting with the Education Enterprise Agreement. Available to primary schools, secondary schools and sixth form colleges, it's ideal for anyone who's been on a TLP or CLP for the last few years, not least because it uses the same management portal and offers flexible deployment options. What is included in EEA?

All of Adobe's Creative Cloud apps! There are also two add-on bundles available – one including Presenter and Captivate and the other made up of Premiere Elements and Photoshop Elements. Adobe services like tech support are not included, but our team can help you with those.

How do I know if my school is eligible?

Eligibility for an EEA is based on your school's FTE number. Smaller schools need an FTE number of 20 or higher to qualify, larger schools need 70 or higher, and Academy Trusts who want to purchase on behalf of all the schools in their group will need an FTE number of 300 or more. Higher education institutions are not eligible for EEA, but can sign up for Creative Cloud using Adobe's VIP scheme.

Is a device specific option available?

Yes, Adobe's Value Incentive Plan allows you to buy licences on a per device or per named user basis. Get in touch to find out more!

How do I work out my school's FTE number?

Your FTE number is the number of full time equivalent staff you employ, and is used by organisations like Adobe to determine the price per licence of large software deployments. Here's the simple formula they're using to work it out:

$$\text{No. full time faculty} + (\text{part time faculty} \div 3) + \text{full time staff} + (\text{part time staff} \div 2) = \text{your FTE count}$$

Adobe reckon a part time staff member is anyone who works 200 hours per annum or less.

You can choose a one or two year licence. At the end of your term, our team can renew some or all of your licences, and add new ones if you need them.

Are product updates included?

Yep! Once you're enrolled, your technical team will be given access to Creative Cloud Packager, Adobe's service for distributing Creative Cloud apps. Updates will be made available in Packager, and your team can install them on your school's machines whenever is most convenient.

How do I enrol?

You can enrol a school as a single site, or a group of schools under the management of a larger administrative body, like an LEA.

All licences on the EEA are managed through LWS, Adobe's licensing portal, which will be familiar to anyone who was previously on a CLP or TLP agreement.

How do I install Creative Cloud once I'm enrolled?

Once you've enrolled online, you'll be given access to Creative Cloud Packager, where your technical team can bundle together applications into different packages and remotely install them on machines around your school. Different packages can be assigned to different users (eg students or teachers) and departments.
